***The State Digital Equity Capacity Award Amounts** (first column) were awarded to States and Territories based on a formula Congress devised and included in the Digital Equity Act. In 2024, NTIA published the amounts that states and territories would receive in their first tranche of the capacity awards. Two future tranches were promised in FY 2025 and FY 2026. We have estimated the amounts the future tranches would contain for each state based on the proportion of the total available amount each state received in the first tranche of funding. The figures in the Estimated Total Capacity Award column are the sum of the current Capacity allocations announced in 2024 and our estimate of the future two tranches.

****The Total DEA \$ Allocated** column (fourth column) provides the estimated total based on the current allocations announced to date. This estimated total is the sum of the Estimated Total Capacity Award (current allocation and estimated future tranches) and the Competitive Grant Total In-State Awards. While NTIA published the total award amounts for each grantee recommended for the Competitive grant, they did not publish the breakdown of the awards for the multi-state grantees. Therefore, this column does not account for the funds the multi-state Competitive Grant projects would distribute to communities within states via their projects. This also does not account for future Competitive allocations that were not announced or intended to be allocated in FY 2026. Nor does it account for the Native Entity allocations that have not been announced yet. As such, the figures in this column represent the **MINIMUM** amount of DEA funds that would be allocated to the state government and organizations within each state and territory.
