



Net Inclusion 2026 Media Policy

The individual registering for Net Inclusion 2026 agrees to these terms for media consent:

The individual certifies that they are 18 years of age or older.

By registering for Net Inclusion 2026, the individual recognizes that they will be in areas where photography, audio and video livestreaming and recording are occurring. The individual's entry and presence at Net Inclusion constitutes consent to the policy outlined below.

By registering, the individual consents to be photographed, filmed, and/or otherwise recorded at the event and related conference events of Net Inclusion 2026. The individual consents to the use, release, publication, exhibition, or reproduction of all recorded media of their appearance, voice, and name and/or information gathered about or including themselves, by NDIA (the Organization) and its initiatives for any purpose whatsoever in perpetuity, including, by way of example only, use on websites, in social media, news, advertising, and other networks/channels.

In giving this consent, the individual releases the Organization and all third parties from liability for any violation of any personal or proprietary right the individual may have in connection with any sale, reproduction or use of the digital media. The individual waives and releases any claims related to the use of recorded media, including, without limitation, any right to inspect or approve the photo, video or audio recording of you, any claims for invasion of privacy, violation of the right of publicity, defamation, and copyright infringement or for any fees for use of such record media.
